# **Projects**

## **Founders Day**

Founders' Day 2022 was an event to commemorate the first day of class held at Ohio State and serves to educate the student body about the history of Ohio State. This year's project honored the centennial year of Ohio Stadium. Ohio Staters collaborated with University Archives and their display in Thompson Library. The event was on September 16th from 12 pm – 3 pm and included a scavenger hunt with a cookie incentive. Fully completed scavenger hunt sheets were entered in a raffle for a free tour of the stadium.





### Omens on the Oval

Omens of the Oval is an event which combines ghost tours of the oval with Orton Bell tours. The event took place on October 26th, 2022, and was centered around Orton Hall. Both tours of the oval and of the bell tower left from the Orton Hall lobby area, with Staters guiding both tours.
